Community Center Committee Update

Community Center Committee Update – August 30th Meeting

The Community Center Committee held a special meeting on August 30th to address several time sensitive items impacting our shared spaces:

*Repairs to the Community Center Entry

A vote was taken to hire a contractor to make long overdue repairs to the exterior entrance of the community center. This improvement will preserve the beautiful log beams and enhance both safety and curb appeal.

*Refresh of the Great Room and Board Room

The committee voted to approve the purchase of new furniture for the great room and conference room, with a budget of \$10,000*. (*These funds will come from our reserve. There will be no increase in dues for this project.)

A heartfelt thank you to the appointed Furniture Committee:

- Lynn Haueter and Barbara Coffman representing Mission Bay HOA
- Joan Grimes and Ginny DuBrucq representing the Preserve HOA

These dedicated ladies have invested countless hours researching quality furnishings that will serve our community well into the future. Updates include:

- New square tables have been ordered and will be paired with new dining chairs. They will coordinate nicely with the existing round oak tables and castor chairs to provide expanded seating for social events, game clubs, etc.
- Coordinating barrel chairs replace the oversized couches to allow for a cozy conversational area by the fireplace.
- Oversized couches and chairs have been removed, creating space for large, seated gatherings without the strain of moving heavy furniture
- · Bookshelves and books have been relocated to the foyer for easier access and a more open layout

*Social Committee Funds Resolution

The committee also reviewed and resolved matters related to the Social Committee's funding to ensure continued support for community events and gatherings. Thank you to everyone involved for your time, care, and commitment to making Mission Bay a welcoming and well-maintained place to live.

Updated Facilites Rules and Regulations

Exercise Room Rules

- The exercise room is open to Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve Homeowners and their guests 24 hours a day. (Homeowners may invite a maximum of two guests)
- When others are waiting, the maximum use of any equipment is 30 minutes.
- Children under the age of 16 must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Please wipe down all equipment after use.

Pool & Spa Hours and Rules (*when open)

- Hours: 8 A.M. to Dusk
- Pool & Spa use is for Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve homeowners and their guests.
- Children under the age of 14 must always be accompanied by an adult.
- Children under the age of 5 are not permitted to use the Spa.
- Swimwear: Swimwear is permitted when exiting the bathrooms to the door leading to the pool & spa area only. Swimwear is prohibited in all other areas of the Community Center building as well as the tennis and pickleball courts.

Pickleball & Tennis Court Rules

- Courts are reserved for Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve owners and their guests only. (Homeowners are restricted to a maximum of two guests)
 - Hours: 8 A.M. 12 P.M. and 6 P.M. until Dusk: Courts are open for Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve Owners and their overnight guests.
 - 12 P.M. 6 P.M.: Courts are open for Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve Owners and any guests not staying overnight. Limit one court per household. If all courts are full, Mission Bay and Mission Bay Preserve owners may join in play.
- At all times, if all courts are occupied, players must rotate play to accommodate waiting players. (Play is limited at these times to one set, then rotation)

General Court Rules

- Courts are restricted for tennis and pickleball use ONLY. Any other use is prohibited.
- Court shoes are required; no hard sole shoes are permitted. (Please also be sure to check for loose impediments in court shoes before playing.)
- Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Please keep noise to a minimum out of respect for adjoining neighbors.
- Courts may not be reserved.
- Please ensure the exit door is securely closed upon exiting.



From the Design Review Committee Re: Taking Out the Old and Replacing with...

I sat down and started to make a list of all the projects the DRC has reviewed this year and honestly, it was just too daunting! It was A LOT! It's been busy but truly fun to watch all the beatification and updating in the neighborhood. With fall in full swing, the requests for project reviews and approvals have dramatically slowed so this will be just a short reminder:

- 1. If you're planning on any exterior changes, please complete the "Outdoor Change Request Form" found on the Mission Bay HOA website and turn it in to Caras Property Management at 215 Main Street. Caras will then notify the committee who will then approve or disapprove the project. After which, Caras will let you know the results. Following this procedure ensures that records are kept.
- 2. If you are removing planters, trees or other landscaping, please make sure you note on the form what you intend to replace it with. This saves the committee much time in not having to contact you for clarification.
- 3. If you are painting, roofing, or adding any type of hardscape, please include pictures or samples of the material(s) you intend to use.
